<p>To learn about the many reasons why people in the medieval period went on pilgrimage.</p> <p>To understand the key differences and similarities between medieval pilgrimage and pilgrimage today.</p> <p>To form a substantive answer to the enquiry question based on the learning from the lesson.</p>	<p>The Church was very important in medieval life, religious belief encompassed all aspects of daily living.</p> <p>Concepts of heaven, hell and purgatory, studied through the image of a Doom painting.</p> <p>Purgatory was not seen as a permanent place to remain, and indulgences could help speed up time in purgatory.</p> <p>Introduction to pilgrimage and the many overlapping reasons why medieval people went on pilgrimage</p> <p>Key differences and similarities between medieval pilgrimage and pilgrimage today.</p> <p>Necessary practical considerations for medieval pilgrims.</p>	<p>PPT 1: Bell work</p> <p>Students look at the images and suggest links between all three.</p> <p>Teacher talk to establish the church was extremely important in the lives of people in the medieval period.</p> <p>PPT 2-3: Intro to enquiry question</p> <p>PPT 4-7: Main Activity 1</p> <p>Heaven, hell and purgatory. Teacher talk for background.
